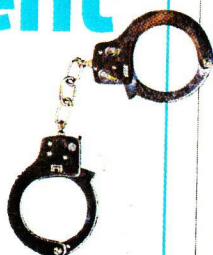

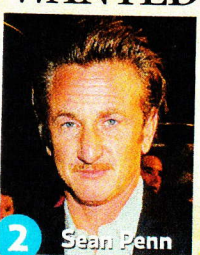

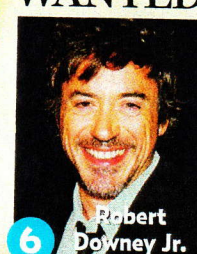

THE GOLDEN COMPASS

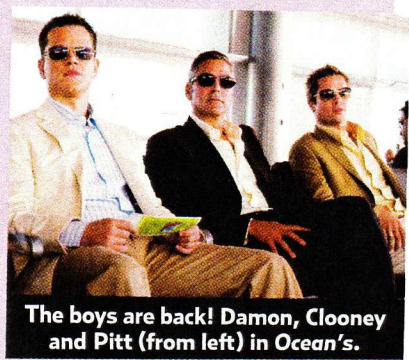
