**'Tampa Brady' Schools the Kids in Super Bowl Rout:** The Tampa Bay Buccaneers [overpowered](#) the Kansas City Chiefs last night to win the franchise's second Super Bowl 31 - 9.

**Tampa quarterback Tom Brady, 43, is the oldest to win the championship game.**

**The numbers tell an incredible story:** Brady has played in the Super Bowl in 10 of 21 seasons played — an astounding 47%.

**For comparison, that's better than the three-point average of NBA superstar Steph Curry, who made 43% of his career three-point shots.**

**In other words, it's more likely that Tom Brady plays in a Super Bowl than Steph Curry makes a three-pointer. That's what you call The Greatest of All Time.**

## **The Great Global Vaccination Effort Takes Hold.**

**More than 131 million doses** of a coronavirus vaccine have been administered across 73 countries, including 42 million in the U.S., according to [data](#) collected by Bloomberg.

**Israel, at the top of the global vaccination race**, has provided at least the first dose of a vaccine to nearly 40% of its population. This equates to 58 doses per 100 people in the country.

**In the U.S., 8.7% of the population** has received their first dose of a vaccine, which means administrators have given 11.17 doses per 100 people.

**Other countries with high vaccination rates** include the United Arab Emirates and the UK, both of which have administered more than 10 doses per 100 people. In Europe, the rates range from 2.82 per 100 people in France to 5.13 doses per 100 in Denmark.

**China, which is currently** reporting around 60 new cases per day, has administered just 2.23 doses per 100 people.

**It's the beginning** of a long effort.

**“More than three-quarters of vaccinations** are in just ten countries that account for almost 60% of the global GDP, and almost 130 countries with 2.5

billion people have yet to administer a single dose," explains [\*\*Dr. Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus\*\*](#), Director-General of the World Health Organization, which [\*\*confirmed\*\*](#) Mike Bloomberg for his third term as WHO Global Ambassador for Noncommunicable Diseases on Feb. 3.

## **N.Y. Expands Vaccine Access to People With Chronic Conditions.**

**Good News For New Yorkers: [Gov. Cuomo Expands List of Those Eligible for Vaccine to People With Cancer, Heart Conditions, Obesity, More](#)** (New York Times)

**Some of the [conditions](#) that would qualify people to be eligible for the vaccine as of Feb. 15 include cancer, heart conditions, lung diseases, liver disease, diabetes, obesity, diabetes and pregnancy — although the CDC's advisory committee has told pregnant women to consult with their doctors before receiving the vaccine.**

**New York Gov. Andrew Cuomo's announcement came** as he said that state health data showed that 75 percent of New York's hospital workers had received at least one dose of the vaccine.

**The state will give hospitals** one more week to inoculate remaining employees before it begins to reallocate vaccine doses to give them to people with comorbidities.
